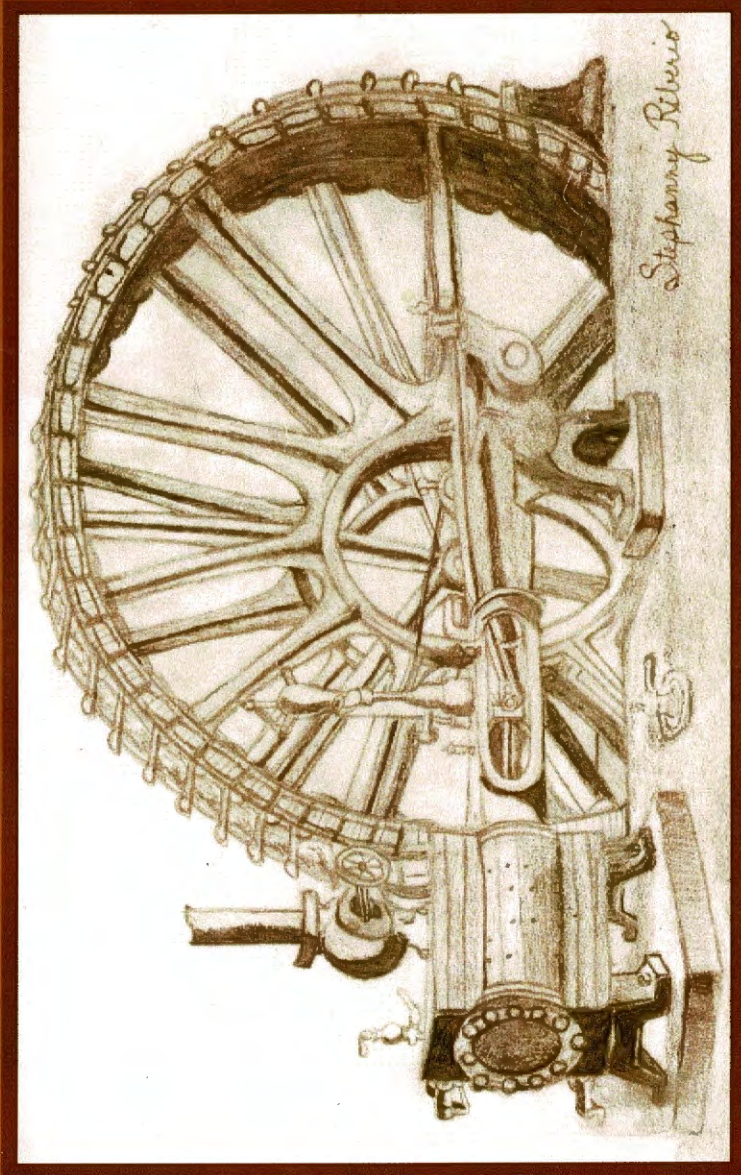

**BILL BUCHMAN** Bill's brightly colored spontaneous abstractions and expressive figure drawings may be seen widely in private and public collections in Denmark, Sweden, England and the US. Accomplished as both artist and educator, Buchman, gives workshops and seminars around the US. In addition to his popular DVD series, his innovative and popular book, "Expressive Figure Drawing" (Random House/Watson-Guptill/2010) may be found in many museum bookstores, including the Tate Museum in London.

Bill studied art with renowned teachers Victor D'Amico at the Museum of Modern Art's Institute of Modern Art, East Hampton, NY and leading American figurative painter Fletcher Martin at the Albany Institute of Art, Albany, NY. Bill attended Cornell University, School of Fine Arts and Boston University, School of Liberal Arts and has a Bachelor's Degree and a Master's Degree in music from the New England Conservatory of Music.

Before moving in 2001 to Sarasota, Florida, Bill worked and exhibited for twenty years in Europe primarily in Scandinavia. In Florida, Bill has been giving regular weekly classes in both figure drawing and abstraction at the Ringling College - Longboat Key Center for the Arts and at the Venice Art Center. Bill also has a blues band, the Art of Blues. He is also an Alumni Montessori parent, his son Noah Buchman is a former NewGate kid.

His topic this evening is "What is an 'art is.'" No, that's not a typo.
